being a by-law to authorize the execution of agreement with Bruno Roy for Dog Control Service

The Corporation of the Township of McGarry enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Reeve and Clerk-Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement with Bruno Roy for Dog Control Services, a copy of which Agreement is attached and marked as schedule "A" to this By-law.

THIS AGREEMENT made this ____day of September, 1997

BETWEEN:

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MCGARRY

(hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation")

OF THE FIRST PART

AND

BRUNO ROY

(hereinafter referred to as "the Contractor")

OF THE SECOND PART

WHEREAS the Corporation, located at 27 Webster Street, Virginiatown, Ontario, desires to engage the services of the Contractor to perform Dog Control Services in the Township of McGarry;

AND WHEREAS the Contractor desires to perform such services for the consideration hereinafter set forth;

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES HERETO in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein DO HERBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Corporation hereby agrees:
 - (a) to appoint and does hereby appoint the Contractor as Dog Control Officer and his employees as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers and said officers may exercise the powers of a peace officer for the purpose of enforcing the dog control and dog licensing by-law and related legal process serving for the Corporation with the duties of such Dog Control Officer and Municipal Law Enforcement Officers to be exercised by the Contractor to pick up and impound any dogs in accordance with the provisions of the Dog Control and Licensing By-Law No. 94-7.
 - (b) to pay to the Contractor as remuneration for his services as Dog Control Officer and Municipal Law Enforcement Officers an annual sum of \$ 4560.00 to be paid monthly, in arrears, in the amount of \$ 380.00 payable on the last day of each month during the period from September 1st, 1997 to August 31st, 1998 the first of such payments to be made the last day of September 1997.
 - (c) to pay to the contractor the sum of \$40.00 for each dog he is required to kill.
 - (d) to grant to the Contractor and the Corporation does hereby grant to the Contractor the right to dispose of all dogs impounded which become the property of the Corporation in accordance with the by-law No. 94-7.

- (e) to grant to the Contractor and the Corporation does hereby grant to the Contractor the right to dispose of the carcasses of all dogs lawfully impounded and lawfully destroyed in accordance with the by-law No. 94-7.
- (f) to grant to the Contractor and the Corporation does hereby grant to the Contractor the right to collect and retain all pound fees, fines, destruction fees and all other fees that either the Contractor or the Corporation may levy from time to time in connection with the provision by the Contractor of dog control or humane services;
- 2. Where the Corporation owns the shelter/pound facility and where the Corporation agrees to lease said facility to the Contractor, the Corporation agrees:
 - (a) to lease said facility for an annual fee of \$ 1.00.
 - (b) to maintain said facility and all equipment installed therein by the Corporation.
 - (c) to maintain said facility in accordance with the Regulations of the Province of Ontario Animals for Research Act.
 - (d) to insure said facility under the Township of McGarry Fire Insurance Program
 - (e) to provide, at the Corporation's expense, electrical power and electrical heating at said facility as may be required by the Contractor.
- 3. Where the Contractor agrees to lease the shelter/pound from the Corporation, the Contractor agrees:
 - (a) to pay to the Corporation an annual rental fee of \$ 1.00.
 - (b) to maintain the leased facility in a clean condition in accordance with the Province of Ontario Animals for Research Act.
 - (c) to operate and use that equipment and the facility, being the property of the Corporation, in a manner so as not to knowingly abuse or destroy said property.
 - (d) to keep the Contractor and the Corporation properly insured in respect to public liability and property damage including claims in respect to injury and loss and\or death of any dog in the following amounts:

Public Liability and Property Damage \$ 1,000,000.00 Erroneous Death or Injury to an Animal \$ 25,000.00

(e) to pay telephone costs associated with the operation of the said shelter/pound facility; and any legal costs required to enforce the Dog Control and Licensing By-Law No. 94-7 at the discretion of the Contractor.

- (f) to supply all equipment necessary for the proper operation of the dog shelter i.e. food, water, cleaning materials.
- (g) to keep the Shelter open for and in operation on such days at such hours as required by the Province of Ontario Animals for Research Act to ensure that the owners of impounded dogs have a reasonable opportunity to reclaim such dogs.
- (h) to provide dead dog pick up Sunday to Saturday during daylight hours.
- (i) to receive, impound and hold for claiming by the owners any dogs delivered to the shelter and to dispose of same as per the terms of Section 12 (4) of the Dog Control and Licensing By-Law No. 94-7.
- (j) to charge such pound and other fees as may be approved from time to time by the Corporation
- (k) to make available to residents of the Corporation a programme of humane services in accordance with the general custom of the Pound.
- (1) to deliver to the Corporation a written statement of the operations of the shelter upon request;
- (m) to supply dog tags and to retain all revenue derived from the sale of said tags.
- 4. This agreement shall commence the 1st day of September 1997 and terminate the 31st day of August 1998.
- 5. In the eventuality that the Contractor makes default or delays in executing the work and services under this Agreement, or otherwise to observe the provisions of this Agreement to the satisfaction of the Corporation, the Corporation may give notice to the Contractor of such default, delay, or failure. Should the Contractor fail to remedy the default, delay or failure to the satisfaction of the Corporation within the time limit specified in the notice, or should the Contractor become insolvent or abandon the work, the Corporation may terminate the Agreement.
- 6. The Contractor represents that it is an independent contractor and agrees that it is not authorized to act as and agent or employee of the Corporation and nothing contained shall be deemed to constitute the Contractor as an agent and/or employee of the Corporation.
- 7. Any Notice, required or permitted, to be given hereunder shall be sufficiently given by registered mail, postage prepaid addressed as follows:

and notice shall be deemed to have been received and be effective on the first business day after mailing. Either party hereto may change its address for service at any time by notice given to the other in the manner aforesaid.

8. This Agreement may be terminated by either Party hereto upon ninety (90) days written notice of intention to terminate.
