THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MCGARRY

BY-LAW 98-24

BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH REMUNERATION AND EXPENSES FOR MEMBERS OF COUNCIL.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, Section 242 provides that the Council of a municipality may pass by-laws for paying remuneration to members of Council.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MCGARRY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **DEFENITIONS**:

In this by-law and in the attached schedules:

(a) "REMUNERATION" means any salary, indemnity, or allowance, onethird of which shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of duties as a member of Council.

2. <u>PROVISIONS</u>

- (a) Members of Council shall receive remuneration as determined according to the provisions of "Schedule A", attached to and forming part of this by-law.
- (b) Members of Council's remuneration, provided for in this by-law, shall be paid by the Clerk-Treasurer/Administrator by the first meeting of every month. The remuneration paid will be for the previous month.

SCHEDULE "A"

By-Law 98-24

Of the Corporation of the Township of McGarry

Remuneration of Council Members

- a) The remuneration to the Reeve for duties shall be \$605.00 per month.
- (b) The remuneration to Councillors for duties shall be \$430.00 per month.
- (c) That all members of Council receive a \$600.00 per annum payable in December for medical benefits.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This by-law shall come into effect on the first day of January 1, 1998.

That all by-laws, or parts thereof, contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
