CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MCGARRY

BY-LAW 2001-02

Being a By-Law to establish Remuneration and Expenses for Members of Council

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, Section 242 provides that Council of a Municipality may pass By-Laws for payment of Remuneration and expenses for Member of Council.

AND WHEREAS Council is desirous to establish remuneration for members of Council.

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the Township of McGarry ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That all members of Council shall be paid a remuneration as established in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this By-Law.
- 2. That Remuneration shall be defined as a salary, indemnity or allowance, one third of which shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of duties as a member of Council.
- 3. The Remuneration provided for in this By-Law shall be paid at the beginning of each month of the year.
- 4. That this by-law shall take effect on the first day of January, 2001.
- 5. That By-Law 98-24 be and is hereby repealed.

REMUNERATION:

- a) Remuneration for the Reeve for duties performed shall be \$700.00 per month.
- b) Remuneration for the Councillors for duties performed shall be \$495.00 per month.
- c) That all members of Council shall receive a payment of \$600.00 per annum, payable in December for payment of Medical expenses.
