

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MCGARRY

BY-LAW 2004-01

Being a By-Law to establish a Tourist Centre Committee

WHEREAS the Township of McGarry and the Township of Larder Lake jointly constructed and operated a Tourist Information Centre.

AND WHEREAS, under the provisions of By-Law 1999-16 the Township of McGarry purchased the Township of Larder Lake portion of the Tourist Information Centre.


AND WHEREAS, the Township of McGarry is desirous to appoint a Tourist Information Centre Committee to assist in the operation of the Centre and to promote tourism within the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the Township of McGarry enacts as follows:

- 1) That Council shall from time to time appoint a nine member committee consisting of 7 members of the public and two members of Council
- 2) That all members appointed shall serve at the pleasure of Council but generally shall serve for the term of Council.
- 3) In the case of a vacancy the Council shall appoint a member to serve the remainder of the term.
- 4) All members of the Committee shall serve without remuneration.
- 5) That the Committee shall meet from time to time and:
 - a) A quorum being a minimum of 5 members shall be required for a meeting.
 - b) That all meetings of the Committee shall be open to the public.
 - c) That the Committee shall keep minutes of their meetings and the minutes will be submitted to Council for approval.
- 6) That Council shall establish a budget for the Tourist Information Centre yearly as part of their budget.
- 7) That all accounts for the Tourist Centre shall be paid from the Township Office and all revenues collected at the Tourist Centre shall be deposited into the Township Office.

- 8) That the Committee may prepare a terms of reference to outline their goals and objectives to provide direction to the members and these shall be approved by Council.
- 9) That By-Law 2000-04 be hereby repealed.

READ a first , second and third time and passed this 14th day of January, 2004.
