## **Township of McGarry**

## BY-LAW 2004-20

Being a By-Law to Regulate the use of All-Terrain Vehicles.

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario has enacted Regulation 316/03, under the provisions of the Highway Traffic Act.

AND WHEREAS Council is desirous to allow All-Terrain Vehicles to be driven on Streets within the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the Township of McGarry enacts as follows:

- 1) In this By-Law
  - a) "Street, Highway and Laneway" means a highway as defined in the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990.
  - b) All-Terrain Vehicle means off-road Vehicle that
    - I) has four wheels, the tires of all which are in contact with the ground
    - ii) has streering handlebars
    - iii) has a seat that is designed to be straddled by the driver
    - iv) is designed to carry a driver only and no passengers
- 2) All-Terrain Vehicles shall be permitted on Streets and Laneways within the Township of McGarry subject to the provisions of Ontario Regulation 316/03.
- 3) No person shall operate an All-Terrain Vehicle over or upon
  - a) Any Municipal owned or Municipal maintained lands used for park, playground, recreation or Utility purposes.
  - b) On any private property without the consent of the owner.
  - c) on any sidewalk.
- 4) Any person who contravenes any of the Provisions of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act.
- 5) That this By-Law shall take effect on the date of its passing.

READ a first, second and third time and passed this 27th day of April, 2004.
