

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MCGARRY

BY-LAW NO. 2006-32

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR HANDICAP PARKING SPACES AT MUNICIPALLY OWNED FACILITIES.

WHEREAS COUNCIL IS DESIROUS TO PROVIDE FOR HANDICAP PARKING SPACES AT THEIR FACILITIES.

AND WHEREAS SECTION 11 (1) (8) OF THE MUNICIPAL ACT, 2001 AUTHORIZES COUNCIL TO ENACT BY-LAWS REGULATION PARKING, EXCEPT ON HIGHWAYS.


NOW THEREFORE, COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MCGARRY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Council does designate Handicap Parking Spaces at the following facilities:
 - a) Community Centre - 2 places
 - b) Medical Centre - 1 place
 - c) Tourist Information Centre - 1 place
2. THAT these parking places shall be designated by placing signs in front of them.
3. The manner of identifying vehicles able to use these designated parking spots shall be a disabled parking permit issued under and displayed in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act and regulations made under it.
4. THAT this By-Law shall not come into affect until proper signs, as outlined in Ontario Regulation 1990/581 as amended are properly installed.
5. Every person who contravenes this By-Law is guilty of an offence, and upon conviction is liable to a fine of not less then \$60.00 and not more than \$500.00.
