**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2010-20 BY-LAW 2010-20 BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR MAINTAINING LAND IN A CLEAN AND CLEAR CONDITION.
(CLEAN YARDS BY-LAW)**


WHEREAS Council adopted By-Law 2010-20 a By-Law to provide for Maintaining Land in a Clean and Clear Condition.

AND WHEREAS Council is desirous to establish offences and fines under the Provincial Offences Act.

- 1) That Section 3.3 of By-Law 2010-20 be and is hereby repealed and shall be replaced with the following;
 - 3.3 No owner shall fail to comply with an order to eliminate or correct standing or stagnant water. Not limiting the foregoing, such order may include a direction to fill or drain off the water or the treatment of the same with larvicide.
- 2) That Schedule "B" to By-Law 2010-20 shall be amended as follows;
 - a) Column 2., of Schedule "B" shall be amended to read "Provision Creating or Defining Offence".
 - b) That item 2 of Schedule "B" shall be amended to read "Fail to comply with an order to eliminate or correct standing or stagnant water".
- 3) That the Heading and General Penalty Provision citations on Schedule "B" to By-Law 2010-20 make reference that they have been amended by By-Law 2010-33.

READ a first, second and third time and passed this 9th day of November , 2010.

4	Dumping, burying, or disposing of refuse, domestic or industrial waste on any lands within Township of McGarry	5.1	\$110
5	Storing used motor vehicles for wrecking or salvage anywhere within the Township of McGarry.	7.1	\$110
6	Obstructing Officer or Agent in the Lawful exercise or power of duty.	13.1	\$110
