

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MCGARRY

BY-LAW 2010-25

BEING A BY-LAW TO REDUCE SPEED LIMIT AND REGULATE TRAFFIC FLOW ON TOWNSHIP ROADWAYS.

WHEREAS Section 128 (2) of the Highway Traffic Act, RSO 1990, Chapter H.8 allows the Council of a Municipality to prescribe by way of By-Law, a rate of speed different from the rate set out in Subsection (1) that is not greater than 100 kilometres per hour for motor vehicles driven on a highway or portion of a highway under its jurisdiction.

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Township of McGarry deems it necessary to reduce the speed limit on a portion of a street for safety reasons.

AND WHEREAS Sections 8, 9 and 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001. C.25 authorize the Municipality to pass By-Laws as necessary respecting the health, safety and well being of persons,

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary to control the direction of traffic on a portion of a street within the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the Township of McGarry enacts as follows

1. That the speed limit for motor vehicles travelling on the roadway listed below be reduced to 20 kilometres per hour and that signs be posted in a conspicuous place at each approach to this section of roadway identifying the speed limit.

<u>Designated Roadway</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Time Period in effect</u>
Connell Avenue	Colville Street and Township Boat Launch	At all Times

2. That to improve public safety and further regulate traffic flow, Council will designate portions of Connell Avenue between Colville Street and the Township Boat Launch for one way traffic only.
3. That proper signs shall be posted showing which portions of Connell Avenue will be limited to one way traffic.

READ A THIRD AND PASSED THIS 21ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2010.
