THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MCGARRY

BY-LAW 2017-35

BEING A BY-LAW TO REDUCE SPEED LIMIT AND REGULATE TRAFFIC FLOW ON ALL TOWNSHIP ROADWAYS.

WHEREAS Section 128 (2) of the Highway Traffic Act, RSO 1990, Chapter H.8 allows the Council of a Municipality to prescribe by way of By-Law, a rate of speed different from the rate set out in Subsection (1) that is not greater than 100 kilometres per hour for motor vehicles driven on a highway or portion of a highway under its jurisdiction.

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Township of McGarry deems it necessary to reduce the speed limit on all streets for safety reasons.

AND WHEREAS Sections 8, 9 and 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001. C.25 authorize the Municipality to pass By-Laws as necessary respecting the health, safety and well being of persons,

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary to control the direction of traffic on all streets within the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the Township of McGarry enacts as follows

1. That the speed limit for motor vehicles travelling on all roadways within the municipality be reduced to 30 kilometres per hour, unless otherwise specified and that signs be posted in a conspicuous place identifying the speed limit.
